

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) is resubmitting the Architectural Recordation forms and photographs for the Upper Tram Camp at Northeast Cape on Saint Lawrence Island to meet stipulations I.A.1. and I.A.3. of the *Memorandum of Agreement between the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and the Alaska State Historic Preservation Officer Regarding the Environmental Restoration of the Hoonah and Northeast Cape White Alice Communication System (WACS) Sites, Alaska, under the Formerly Used Defense Sites Program (MOA)*. This MOA has an extended termination date of December 31, 2002 (letter from Bittner to McConnell, December 12, 2001). All other stipulations for the MOA have been met with the exception of these products. Comments by your staff have been considered and resulted in a second visit to the Upper Tram Camp for additional photographs in 2001 and extensive additions to the Architectural Recordation forms.
